

Antonio Negri came to international prominence with the publication of Empire (written with his collaborator Michael Hardt, and published by Harvard University Press in 2000), which argued that just as the current forms of global sovereignty are decentered and global, so are the forms of liberation that should supersede it. On our first meeting, we will discuss the first part of Empire, and present a tentative schedule for our remaining meetings during 2016-17.
